Players in NJ Youth Soccer may only have one Travel Member Pass (i.e. primary card). "Dual" or "Double" carding, where a player has a primary NJYS membership with more than one team or club, is not permitted.

NJ Youth Soccer permits secondary permissions, currently managed at the league level, for 9U through 19U players. Note that this is not permitted for 6U through 8U. For the NJYS affiliated leagues in which RSC teams play (i.e. MCYSA or EDP), secondary carding is allowed with an additional fee and a process/restrictions specific to each league. In general, the idea with secondary carding is that a player is primary carded to one club but applies for and receives permission to secondary card to a team at a different club. RSC's Operating Guidelines continue to allow secondary carding with the prior approval of RSC's Board.

For the 2024-25 season, RSC's Board remains open to approving secondary carding requests. Thus, a question about secondary carding is being included as part of tryout registration; so we can plan appropriately as we head into team formation.

RSC will need a minimum number of players fully committed to RSC as primary carded players to ensure our ability to field a viable team before any secondary carding requests are considered. The minimum number of primary carded players will depend on the age group and other factors, including the commitment level of the group on a particular team. Note that any additional cost incurred for secondary carding will be the responsibility of the player's family not RSC. Players who are approved to secondary card to an RSC roster will pay the regular club fee for that team.
